AG & STANDARDS INSPECTOR TRAINEE/I/II **TRAINEE: \$2,822-\$3,439; I: \$3, 177-\$3,871 Monthly** **FILING DEADLINE: 09/12/16**

Vacancy with the Ag Commissioner Office in Tulare. Conduct field surveys and inspections that include fruit, vegetable and egg quality; conduct nursery compliance, pest and disease control, and pesticide safety. Requires a Bachelor's degree from an accredited college in agricultural, biological or related discipline. Possession of valid State and Federal inspection licenses/certificates.
