MISSION STATEMENT

The Tulare County Law Library is established under the authority of Chapter 5 of Division 3 of the California Business & Professions Code, comprising of Sections 6300 through 6365 of that Code.

The primary obligation of the library is to provide legal information and information services to members of the legal community and citizens who reside or practice in Tulare County. Secondary obligations are to serve other California county law libraries and citizens outside of Tulare County.
