

# Instructions for Voting and Returning Your Ballot

1. Print each ballot page on one piece of paper (complete ballot may be 1 or 2 sided and either 8 ½ x 11 or 8 ½ x 14 inches in size). Ballot may print very small due to the actual size of the ballot.
2. When printing from Acrobat, select “fit to page” in Print Properties.
3. Print out the “Absentee Ballot Return Envelope image” page. The Return Envelope image includes the declaration and signature lines for your return envelope. Cut out the “return envelope image” and glue or tape it to the outside of the 6 x 9 return envelope.
4. Vote your ballot by completing the arrow to the right of the candidate’s name or to the right of the “Yes” or “No”.
5. Fold the page(s) containing the ballot and place it in the 6 x 9 return envelope you created. Seal the envelope.
6. Print your Tulare County residence address information on the Absentee Ballot Return Envelope where indicated and sign the Voter Declaration. Place your newly created Absentee Ballot Return Envelope, with ballot sealed inside, into another large envelope and address it to:

7. Mail the envelope by whatever means are available in your locality so that the ballot will reach the office **no later than 8pm on Election Day.**

**PLEASE NOTE:** If more than one person is returning a ballot, each person MUST return his or her ballot sealed in a separate envelope with a completed ABSENTEE BALLOT RETURN ENVELOPE image attached.
