Activity/Breakout Session	Description
Open Enrollment & EAP Presentation	An overview of 2024 Health Plan offerings, including changes and enhancements. An overview of the Anthem EAP services will also be reviewed.
Alcohol & Drug Awareness (HHSA Mental Health)	Awareness can make a big difference in preventing drug and alcohol abuse and the topics discuss prevention strategies and various awareness campaigns. Further on, the impact that drug and alcohol dependency can have on an individual's workplace and personal performance is discussed.
Zumba (In Shape & Lindsay Wellness)	Zumba is a fusion of Latin and International music/dance that creates a dynamic, exciting, and fun workout. The routines feature aerobic/fitness interval training with a combination of fast and slow rhythms that tone and sculpt the body.
Normatec and CRYO Therapy (Kaweah Lifestyle)	The NormaTec PULSE Recovery System consists of a compression device that surrounds your arms, legs, or hips. These compression units then utilize compressed air to massage your limbs, leading to mobilized fluid and faster recovery and recuperation following intense exertion. Cryotherapy is the use of extreme cold to freeze and remove abnormal tissue. Doctors use it to treat many skin conditions (including warts and skin tags) and some cancers, including prostate, cervical and liver cancer.
Aikido (TC Aikido)	Martial art and self-defense system that resembles the fighting methods jujitsu and judo in its use of twisting and throwing techniques and in its aim of turning an attacker's strength and momentum against himself.
Deferred Comp 457 (Empower)	The plan is a voluntary savings program that allows employees to defer any amount, subject to annual limits, from their paycheck on a pretax basis. In addition, employee contributions and their earnings, if any, can benefit from the power of tax-deferred compounding.
HIIT Class Workout (Valley Fitness)	HIIT is a type of interval training exercise. It incorporates several rounds that alternate between several minutes of high intensity movements to significantly increase the heart rate to at least 80% of one's maximum heart rate, followed by short periods of lower intensity movements.
Chair Yoga Class (The Space Yoga Studio)	A form of yoga in which modified postures and breathing exercises are performed while seated or with the support of a chair.




