### Verduzco's Proposed Supervisor Districts

# Supervisor District 1

This district will include Exeter, Farmersville, Lindsay, Strathmore, Poplar, Woodville, and part of Visalia. The Visalia portion will be composed of the area south of Riggin Avenue, east of Mooney Boulevard, and north of the 198, except for the Green Acres area. Furthermore, include the area south of 198 between Mooney Boulevard, Tulare Avenue, and Santa Fe Street. Please consider Road 140 as the western boundary south of Avenue 256 and Avenue 120 as the southern border.

### Supervisor District 2

Include Tulare, Tipton, Pixley, Earlimart, and Richgrove. Use Oakdale as the northern boundary.

## Supervisor District 3

Include Visalia south of 198 (except what was noted in Supervisor District 1), Visalia West of Demaree Street, Green Acres neighborhood of Visalia, and Waukena. For clarification, Road 156 will be the eastern boundary for this district, and Oakdale Avenue/ Avenue 256 will be the southern boundary. Popular Avenue will also be the southern boundary, south Waukena.

# Supervisor District 4

Include Cutler, Dinuba, Goshen, Ivanhoe, Orosi, Patterson Tract, and Woodlake, and part of Visalia. Include Visalia north of Goshen between Mooney Boulevard and Demaree Street. Use Avenue 320 as the southern border between Demaree Street and Road 76. Please consider following St. John's River, east of Ben Maddox Way, use St. John's River as the southern boundary.

### Supervisor District 5

Include Porterville, Ducor, Lemon Cove, Terra Bella, Tule River Tribal Lands, and all-mountain communities. District 5 will be an enormous mountain district.

### **Quick Facts**

- Tulare stays together in one district.
- Porterville stays together in one district.
- Tribal lands remain together.
- Communities of interest stay together.
- Three strong Latino CVAP supervisorial districts. 1, 2, and 4.
