## OUTDOOR WATER CONSERVATION STAGE 4

All outdoor irrigation using water from the County System is restricted except as follows:

- ☹ Maintenance of trees & shrubs (not lawns) are watered on same schedule set forth by using a bucket, hand-held hose with positive shut-off nozzle, or low volume non spray irrigation.

### MAY-OCT

**Even Address: WED & SUN**

**Odd Address: TUES & SAT**

### DEC-FEB

**NO OUTDOOR  
WATERING**

### MAR, APR, NOV

**Even Address: SUN ONLY**

**Odd Address: SAT ONLY**

- ☹ Water **only** between 8 P.M. & 6 A.M. on your watering day.
- ☹ All breaks, leaks, or malfunctions must be repaired within forty-eight (48) hours.

The following activities are prohibited year round:

- ☹ Providing or selling water to any other location, residence, or parcel;
- ☹ Over-seeding of lawns with annual ryegrass;
- ☹ Washing sidewalks, driveways, parking areas, patios, or other paved areas with potable water;
- ☹ Washing automobiles, trucks, trailers, or boats with potable water;
- ☹ Using water from fire hydrants for use other than fire fighting activities
- ☹ Operating ornamental fountains, waterfalls, or similar structures not using recycled water;
- ☹ Draining and refilling swimming pools;
- ☹ Using swamp coolers that do not use recirculation pumps;
- ☹ Using potable water for irrigation or construction;
- ☹ Allowing substantial amounts of water to run off to gutter, ditch, or drain.

**Certain limited outdoor watering activities are exempt at all stages, including but not limited to those in the immediate interest of the public health, safety, or welfare.**

**ANY PERSONS VIOLATING ANY PORTION OF ORDINANCE IN EFFECT SHALL BE GUILTY OF AN INFRACTION PUNISHABLE BY A FINE OF TWENTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$25.00) FOR THE FIRST VIOLATION, FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50.00) FOR THE SECOND VIOLATION AND ONE-HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00) FOR THE THIRD AND EACH SUBSEQUENT VIOLATION.**
