Someone will be available to assist you during closed hours of Tulare County RMA.

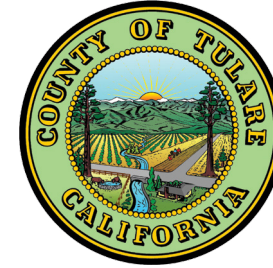

Agriculture Wind Machine/ Ag-Well Emergency Program

PG&E Users

1. Owner or Contractor makes a call to the Emergency Contact Number. SCE users need to leave their contact number for the County Building Inspector to call back.
2. County Building Inspector will call Dispatch to retrieve all information, owner/contractor name, site address and phone number.
3. County Building Inspector will respond back to the owner/contractor ASAP.
4. Owner or Contractor needs to meet the County Building Inspector at a nearby designated location to drive the County Building Inspector to the location of this inspection .
5. The Owner or Contractor is responsible to drive the County Building Inspector to the site.
6. After the inspection, the County Building Inspector will contact the utility company and approve the inspection to release the power.
7. Owner or Contractor needs to apply for an Electrical Building Permit within 2 working days of the electrical reconnection.
8. Minimum 3 hours call out at \$68-hour; \$204 plus the permit fee. For a 100-200 AMP service \$118: 300-400 AMP service \$134 and 500 AMP service \$204.

1. Owner or Contractor makes a call to the Emergency Contact Number.
2. Owner or Contractor needs to apply for an Electrical Building Permit within 2 working days of the electrical reconnection.
3. The permit fees for a 100-200 AMP service \$186; 300-400 AMP service \$202 and 500 AMP service \$318.
