 - Click on any title and it will automatically take you to that section in the document

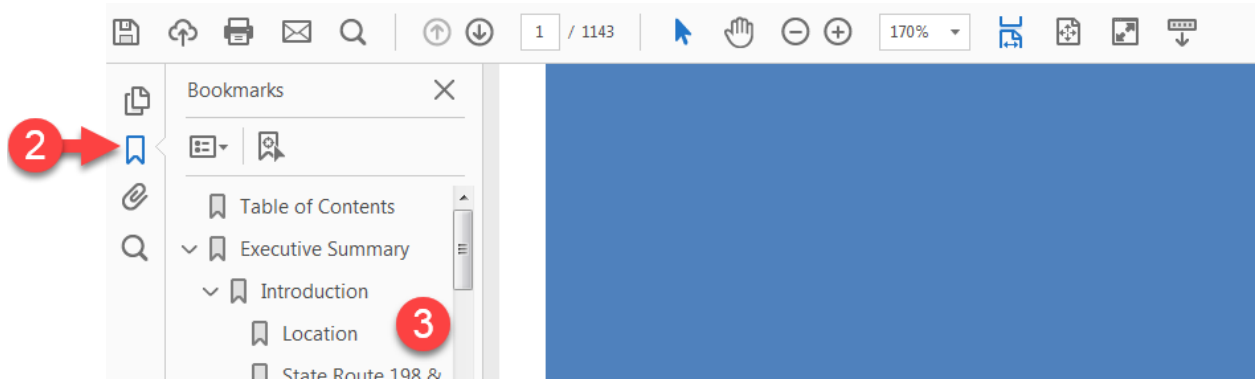

2. Click on the Bookmarks icon to display bookmarks

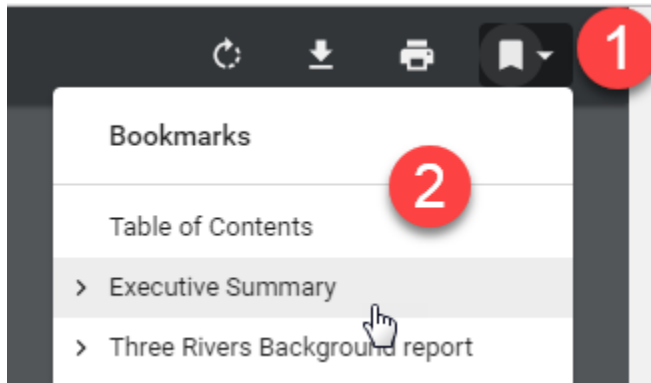


3. Click on the bookmarks to go to specific points of interest using the links
