## 1 BEFORE THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS 2 COUNTY OF TULARE, STATE OF CALIFORNIA 3 4 5 In the Matter of Adoption of a ) Resolution of Intention to Order and ) RESOLUTION No. 95- 0935 6 7 the Ordering of Annexation No. 1 to ) Assessment District No. 92-01-Orosi 8 9 of the County of Tulare, State of California, Pursuant to the 10 Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972. ) 11 12 WHEREAS, the County of Tulare has approved the Final Map of Subdivision Tract No. 13 720; and 14 WHEREAS, Condition No. 23 established by the Planning Commission in its Resolution 15 No. 7318 approving the Tentative Subdivision Map for Tract No. 720 requires an assessment 16 district to pay for the continuing cost of the maintenance of certain improvements which will be 17 located in the Road 124 County right of way dedicated by the Final Map of Subdivision Tract No. 18 19 720 and the Owner/Subdivider has filed an application for and consent to form/annex to such an assessment district; and 20 21 WHEREAS, by its Resolution No. 95-0749, this Board of Supervisors initiated proceedings for the annexation to an Assessment District pursuant to the Landscaping and 22 Lighting Act of 1972, Streets and Highways Code Section 22500 et seq., for the purpose of 23 24 providing for the continuing cost of maintenance of the improvements within the Road 124 25 County right of way dedicated by the Final Map of Subdivision Tract No. 720; and WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 22608 of the Streets and Highways Code the 26 Owner/Subdivider within the territory to be annexed has consented in writing to a waiver of 27 resolution, reports, notices of hearing and right of majority protest with respect to these annexation 28 29 proceedings; and

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WHEREAS, two public hearings have been held by the Board of Supervisors on July 25, 1995 at 9:30 a.m. and August 1, 1995 at 9:30 a.m. in the Board of Supervisors Chambers, Administration Building, 2800 West Burrel, Visalia, California, to receive public comment regarding the Board's intention declared herein and to levy the assessment for Fiscal Year 1995/96 for Annexation No. 1 to Assessment District No. 92-01-Orosi of the County of Tulare, State of California.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED as follows:

- 1. This Board of Supervisors hereby declares its intention to order an annexation to the assessment district known as Assessment District No. 92-01-Orosi of the County of Tulare, State of California, to collect and levy assessments pursuant to the Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972, Streets and Highways Code section 22500 et seq., for the purpose of providing for the continuing cost of maintenance of the various improvements within the Road 124 County right of way dedicated by Final Map of Subdivision Tract Map No. 720, which improvements are described as, and include but are not limited to shrubs, trees, walls and an irrigation system.
- 2. The proposed annexation to Assessment District No. 92-01-Orosi of the County of Tulare, State of California, shall include all the area of the Final Map of Subdivision Tract No. 720, excepting Lot A, and is generally located in the unincorporated community of Orosi between Road 124 and Road 125 north of Avenue 416.
- 3. The assessment diagram labeled "Assessment Diagram, Annexation No. 1 to Assessment District No. 92-01-Orosi of the County of Tulare, State of California", filed with the Clerk of the Board is hereby approved by this Board of Supervisors and provides the boundaries of the annexation to Assessment District No. 92-01-Orosi and any zones therein.
- 4. This Board of Supervisors finds that the Owner/Subdivider of Tract No. 720 owns all property within Tract No. 720 and has consented to the formation/annexation to the assessment district, and has consented to the terms of Tulare County Ordinance Code Section 7008 et seq. requiring the installation of the improvements described by this resolution at the cost of the subdivider, and this Board hereby orders, pursuant to Streets and Highways Code Section 22605, annexation to Assessment District No. 92-01-Orosi of the County of Tulare, State of California,

- 5. The boundaries of the annexation to Assessment District No. 92-01-Orosi of the County of Tulare, State of California, shall be those set out in the map labeled "Proposed Boundaries of Annexation No. 1 to Assessment District No. 92-01-Orosi of the County of Tulare, State of California" filed by the Tulare County Public Works Director with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors which map is hereby approved and confirmed without change.
- 6. Pursuant to the above and by the authority vested in it by the Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972, the Board of Supervisors hereby orders the annexation of the area which boundaries are described by Paragraph No. 5 to the Assessment District No. 92-01-Orosi.
- 7. The assessment to be levied during the 1995-96 fiscal year to pay for the continuing cost of the maintenance of said improvements are those set out in the assessment diagram labeled "Assessment Diagram, Annexation No. 1 to Assessment District No. 92-01-Orosi of the County of Tulare, State of California" filed by the Engineer with the Clerk of the Board hereby approved and confirmed without change to levy an assessment of \$\frac{57.00}{} per parcel.
- 8. The assessment to be levied for the 1995-96 fiscal year under Paragraph No. 6 above shall be collected from the Owner/Subdivider of Tract No. 720 pursuant to an agreement in the form attached hereto. The Chairman of the Board is hereby authorized to execute such agreement on behalf of the County.
- 9. The Clerk of the Board is hereby authorized and directed to file certified copies of the map "Proposed Boundaries of Annexation No. 1 to Assessment District No. 92-01-Orosi of the County of Tulare, State of California" with the County Recorder and certified copies of the "Assessment Diagram, Annexation No. 1 to Assessment District No. 92-01-Orosi of the County of Tulare, State of California" with the County Recorder. The Clerk of the Board of Supervisors is also authorized and directed to execute and record in the office of the County Recorder a notice of assessment substantially in the form set out in Streets and Highways Code Section 3114(f).
