PROCEDURES WHEN NO ONE RUNS FOR POSITION ON BOARD OF ELECTED DISTRICT (Elec. Code, § 10515)

(as of Jan. 1, 2019)

- 1. Officer conducting election¹ notifies Board of Supervisors after nominations period closes (mid-August) that no one ran, certifies that no petition has been filed requesting election anyway.
- 2. Board of Supervisors must appoint no later than last meeting held prior to the Monday before the first Friday in December.
- 4. If Board of Supervisors does not appoint anyone, incumbent holds over until successor elected or appointed and qualifies, or, if incumbent refuses to hold over, position becomes vacant on first day of new term (1st Fri. in Dec.) and procedures under Government Code section 1780 then apply.
