Notice is hereby given that pursuant to **Government Code Section 66018**, the County of Tulare intends to hold a public hearing with respect to the adoption of fees for services provided by the Health and Human Services Agency: Environmental Health, Public Guardian, and Health Operations Divisions.

The hearing is set for April 8, 2025, at 9:30 a.m. or soon thereafter, in the Tulare County Board Chambers located at 2800 W. Burrel, Visalia, California.

The purpose of the hearing is to consider oral and written presentations of any interested party with respect to the proposed increased and/or adjusted fees that would generate revenue to offset costs of services provided within the County Environmental Health, Public Guardian, and Health Operations Divisions.

The proposed fees and the basis for proposals are set forth in a letter to the Board of Supervisors. The recommendations in the letter will be presented to the Board of Supervisors for adoption at the close of the aforementioned public hearing.
