The hearing will pertain to an appeal of Extension of Time No. EOT 22-002 requested by Hartland Christian Camp, 57611 Eshom Valley Drive, Badger, CA 93603, for the request for a two-year extension of time to September 28, 2024, for setback Variance No., PSV 08-003 (ZA) on a 1.0-acre portion of a 12.36-acre site in the A-1 (Agricultural) Zone. The project is located on property approximately three miles northeast of Badger. (APN: 009-050-004). The appropriate environmental determination is a categorical exemption, consistent with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and the State CEQA Guidelines Section 15305, Class 5, pertaining to minor alterations in land use limitations .

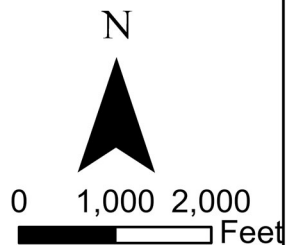
