

County warns of public record solicitors

The Tulare County Assessor/Clerk-Recorder's Office has recently received complaints of residents getting notices in the mail from other companies offering to provide homeowners with copies of county records, including property deeds or other records of title.

County officials said these services are not approved by the Assessor/Clerk-Recorder's Office.

Copies of records can be requested at the office for a fee, typically less than the amount being offered by companies. The office charges \$3 for the first page of a document and \$1 for each additional page of the same document. Certification fee is an additional \$2 for each document.
