Can the school accommodate technology needs for the presentation, such as a microphone and speakers or powerpoint presentation? If not, please let the EPRU know they need to provide those supplies.

How many children will see the presentation? For groups larger than 125, we recommend that they be split up into two groups, for two consecutive presentations.
