I, Cass Cook, Tulare County Tax Collector, hereby announce that regular, secured tax bills will be mailed on or before November 1, 2023, to all property owners at the addresses shown on the tax roll. If you own property in Tulare County and do not receive a tax bill by November 10, contact the Tax Collector's office at Tulare County Tax Collector, 221 S. Mooney Blvd., Room 104-E, Visalia, CA 93291, by emailing taxhelp@tularecounty.ca.gov, or call (559) 636-5250.

Failure to receive a tax bill does not relieve the taxpayer of the responsibility to make timely payments (R & T Code 2610.5).

The **FIRST INSTALLMENT** of 2023-2024 secured property taxes is due and payable on November 1, 2023, and will become delinquent if not paid by 5:00 p.m., or the close of business, whichever is later, on December 11, 2023; thereafter, a 10% penalty will be added. (R & T Code 2605, 2617)

The **SECOND INSTALLMENT** is due on February 1, 2024, and will become delinquent if not paid by 5:00 p.m., or the close of business, whichever is later, on April 10, 2024; thereafter, a 10% penalty will be added, plus the cost to prepare the delinquent tax records and to give notice of delinquency. (R & T Code 2606, 2618)

BOTH INSTALLMENTS MAY BE PAID when the first installment is due.

Payments may be made by electronic funds transfer, online at www.tularecountytax.com, or by mail to Tulare County Tax Collector, P.O. Box 102495, Pasadena, CA 91189-2495.

Mailed payments must be **POSTMARKED BY THE DELINQUENT DATE** to avoid late penalties. Payments may also be made in person at Tulare County Tax Collector's Office, 221 S. Mooney Blvd., Room 104-E, Visalia, CA 93291, between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, holidays excepted.
